As universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the equipment and are a lot less at risk to destruction. These buckets are likewise fifty percent deeper compared to the quick-tach bucket models. This additional room makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads like for example tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete and backfilling behind walls.
